

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

BY-LAW NO. 2018-25

Being a by-law to adopt an Animal Protection policy
for the Township of Prince.

THE COUNCIL of the Corporation of the Township of Prince ENACTS as follows:


1. THAT the Council hereby adopts an Animal Protection Policy for the Township of Prince, as follows:
2. No person shall leave an animal unattended in a motor vehicle unless:
 - a) The animal is restrained in a manner that prevents contact between the animal and any member of the public; and
 - b) The animal has suitable ventilation.
3. Notwithstanding Subsection 1(1) of this By-law, no person shall leave an animal unattended in a motor vehicle if the weather conditions are not suitable for the animal to remain free from distress or injury.
4. Notwithstanding subsection 1(1) of this By-law, no person shall transport an animal outside the passenger compartment of any motor vehicle unless the animal is contained in a kennel or similar device that provides adequate ventilation, adequate space, protects the animal from the elements and is securely fastened in such a manner to prevent distress or injury to the animal.
5. This by-law shall come into force on the date of its final passing.
