BY - LAW # 283.

Of the Township of Prince, in the District of Algoma, entitled a by-law to levy the rates and appoint a Tax Collector for the year 1957.

WHEREAS it is expedient and necessary that a by-law be passed levying the rates on all taxable property in the Township of Prince, as herein~~after~~ mentioned, and to repeal certain by-laws relating thereto; THEREFOR the Corporation of the Township of Prince by the Council thereof ENACTS as follows -

THAT a rate of 72 mills be levied on all taxable farm and residential property in the Municipality.

THAT a rate of 77  $\frac{1}{10}$  mills be levied on all taxable commercial property in the Municipality, the above total rate to be distributed as follows -

THAT Mrs. Margaret Hill be appointed Tax Collector at a commission of 5% of all taxes collected. Collector to be bonded for \$1,000 Council to pay ~~premium~~ premium on same. Delivery of tax notices to be by mail.

THAT last day for payment of taxes shall be September 30 and that any taxes unpaid at that date shall have a penalty of 1% per month added up to December 31. Collector to return roll to Treasurer not later than Dec. 31, 1957.

READ a first, second and third time and finally passed in open Council this 5 th day of June 1957.
