

TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

BY-LAW NO. 295

It is hereby enacted by the Council of the Township of Prince as By-Law No. 295 that a bounty of Five Dollars (\$5.00) shall be paid to each resident of the Township who kills or destroys a fox, within the limits of the said Township.

This bounty shall be paid by the Clerk on the production of skin or pelt of the fox and on satisfying him that it was killed by the person producing it and within the limits of the Township.

The Clerk shall affix his identification mark on the skin or pelt and may then hand it back to the person producing it.

Read a First, Second and Third time and finally passed this 1st day of October, A.D., 1958.
