

TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

BY-LAW NO. 296

This By-Law No. 296 is passed pursuant to Sub-Section Seventeen of Section Three Hundred and Eighty-eight of the Municipal Act and enacts as follows:-

No person shall discharge a gun or other firearm in the said Township within the limit of Five Hundred Yards of any building in the said Township.

A gun or firearm shall include a rifle, pistol or shot-gun; and building shall include a dwelling, a tourist camp or summer camp or a lumberman's camp, whether the same building is occupied or not.

Anyone violating this By-Law shall, upon conviction, be subject to a penalty of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00), payable on such terms as the Magistrate may prescribe.

Read a First, Second and Third time and finally passed this 1st day of October, A.D., 1958.
