

Of the Corporation of the Township of Prince.
A By-Law to License House-trailers or Vehicles
used as Living Quarters within the Township of
Prince.

WHEREAS certain of the population of the Municipality of the Township of Prince reside in House-trailers or vehicles capable of being motorized or propelled by a motor vehicle parked on lands or on the highways within the said Township of Prince:

AND WHEREAS the assessment and taxes on these lands are assumed by the owners:

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to require such resident or residents within the Township to procure and pay for a license for such privilege, fee for this being Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per month, payable in advance:

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Prince enacts as follows :-

(1) THAT the owner or owners, occupant or occupants of any vehicle used for the living, sleeping or eating accommodation of persons therein, which is placed, located, kept or maintained, notwithstanding that such vehicle is jacked-up, or that its running-gear is removed, on any lands or highways within the said Municipality, shall procure a License for such privilege from the Corporation of the Township of Prince.

(2) THAT for such License the person or persons occupying or using the above-mentioned vehicle shall pay a fee of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per month in advance. The license shall be issued by the Building Inspector of the Township and the monthly fee will be payable to the Township Treasurer, Township Clerk or the Township Building Inspector.

(3) THAT property owners, on which such vehicles is placed, located or maintained, shall be responsible for the payment of such License fee should the owner or owners of the above-mentioned vehicle not pay the same.

(4) THAT any person contravening the provisions of this by-law will be liable, on a complaint under The Summary Convictions Act under Part XXI of the Municipal Act, to a penalty not less than Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and not more than Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars, exclusive of costs.

(5) AND THAT it is further provided that any default in payment of the \$10.00 monthly fee, the License shall be suspended during such default.

(6) ANY person holding a license and not wishing to use it further, may have it revoked or cancelled by the Building Inspector and shall not then be liable for further monthly payments.

(7) THIS By-Law is an amending and re-issue of By-Law No. 287 of the said Township of Prince.
