

The Municipal Corporation of the Township of Prince,
enacts as follows.

WHEREAS the Council is desirous of eliminating surface pools and accumulation of rubbish that might be a menace to health and become an eyesore to the citizens, therefore it is enacted as follows :-

1. THAT the Township engineer is authorized to direct the filling up or draining of pools and puddles, and the clearing and cleaning of any grounds, yards or vacant lots in the Township, so that it may eliminate anything that is undesirable from the health and observation viewpoint.
2. THAT any owner or citizen neglecting or refusing to comply with the Engineer's requirements shall be liable on summary conviction to a penalty of not less than \$25.00 and not more than \$50.00.
3. THAT it is further enacted that in this By-Law is also incorporated all power and authority vested in the Township by Section 496 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. Chapter 243.
