BY - LAW # 313

OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE, in the District of Algoma entitled a by-law to levy rates and appoint a Tax Collector for the year 1960.

WHEREAS it is expedient and necessary that a by-law be passed levying rates on all taxable property in the Township of Prince, as hereinafter mentioned, THEREFOR the Corporation of the Township of Prince by the Council thereof ENACTS as follows -

THAT a rate of 63.0 mills be levied on all taxable farm and residential property in the Municipality.

That a rate of 71.1 mills be levied on all taxable commercial property in the Municipality. the above total rate to be distributed as follows-

General Municipal	residential	22.6
	Commercial	30.7
Education		40.4

THAT Lloyd Lemcke be appointed Tax Collector at a commission of 5% of all taxes collected, Collector to be bonded for \$1,000. Council to pay premium on same. Delivery of tax notices to be by mail.

THAT last day for payment of taxes shall be Sept. 30 and that ant taxes unpaid at that date shall have a penalty of 1% per month added up to Dec. 31. Collector to return roll to Treasurer not later than. Dec. 31, 1960.

READ a first, second and third times and finally passed in open Council this 1'st day of June 1960.
