THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

BY-LAW No. 317

Being a By-Law Respecting the Preservation of Residential areas within the Township of Prince

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to limit the expansion of commercial enterprises in the Township of Prince, and to preserve the residential character of certain sections of the Township of Prince,

THEREFORE the Municipality council of the Corporation of the Township of Prince enact as follows:-

That the lands contained within Sections Thirty-one (31) and Thirty-two (32) of the said Township of Prince shall be used solely for residential purposes.

Enforcement: Any person convicted of a breach of provisions of this By-Law shall forfeit and pay at the discretion of the Magistrate a penalty not exceeding the sum of \$50.00 for each offense, exclusive of costs. Each day of continuing breach of this by-law shall constitute a separate offense. The penalties herein provided shall be recoverable under the Summary Convictions Act.

Effective Date: This By-Law shall come into effect on the day it is finally passed by Council, subject to the approval of the Ontario Municipal Board.
