BY-LAW # 324

Of the Township of Prince in the District of Algoma
Whereas it is considered desirable, in order to
control adequately the development of the Township
of Prince, that land, before it is conveyed, shall
be included in a registered plan of subdivision.

And WHEREAS, this concerns the Cress Subdivision
expansion & road maintenance as follows-

- (1) The road called Harper Street which now
extends 400 feet is to be built to
Highway standards and to be maintained to
such time as the Township approves of
same & undertakes responsibilities.
- (2) That this said road does not extend any
further or that any other roads be built
in the future unless brought before the
council and their approval be applied.
- (3) That any further development in said
Subdivision be brought forward to the
Council and approved & the standard
allowance for Parks, Roads, Schools etc.,
be noted & shown in print & complying
with the planning board..

THAT all by-laws and parts of by-laws contrary or
inconsistent to the provisions of this by-law be
and are hereby repealed..
