THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE

BY-LAW NO. 333

Being a By-law respecting the use by Her Majesty the Queen as represented by the Minister of Transport of Canada of the "Existing Forced Road" in the Township of Prince as shown on Plan Number T1868.

The Council of the Corporation of the Township of Prince enacts as follows:-

1. Her Majesty the Queen as represented by the Minister of Transport of Canada, his agents, employees and assigns, shall have the right to use, free of charge, the "Existing Forced Road" in the Township of Prince in the District of Algoma, shown on Plan Number T1868, attached hereto, PROVIDED that the said road is maintained and kept by the said minister in good condition during the period of such use and at the end thereof.
