



**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE**

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**BYLAW 2026 – 23**

**BEING A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH AND ASSUME CERTAIN LANDS AS A PUBLIC HIGHWAY**

**WHEREAS** the Corporation of the Township of Prince is the owner of a 0.3 metre (one-foot) reserve described as **PCL 7564 SEC AWS; BLK B PL M330 PRINCE; PRINCE being PIN 31618-0400(LT**

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Township of Prince passed By-law No. 2025-35 on July 8, 2025, declaring that said one-foot reserve is no longer required for the purposes for which it was established and shall be lifted;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 31 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provides that a municipality shall pass a by-law to establish and assume land as a public highway;


**AND WHEREAS** it is now deemed necessary and expedient to formally establish and assume the said lands as a public highway to provide legal access and frontage for the adjacent lands;

**NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

- 1. THAT** the lands described as **PCL 7564 SEC AWS; BLK B PL M330 PRINCE; PRINCE being PIN 31618-0400(LT** in the Township of Prince, District of Algoma, be and the same are hereby established and assumed as a public highway.
- 2. THAT** the said lands shall hereafter form part of the public highway known as **Douglas Drive**.
- 3. THAT** the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to give effect to this By-law.

4. THAT notwithstanding the date of passage of this By-law, this By-law shall not come into force or take effect until a certified copy of this By-law has been registered in the Land Registry Office for the District of Algoma.
