

GENERAL CONDITIONS TO BE COMPLIED WITH BY PERMIT HOLDER

The holder of this permit acknowledges having received Forest Fire Prevention Act Ont. Reg. 230/00 and will abide by the conditions set out in said regulations and the conditions printed below

The amount to be burned at any one time shall not exceed 1 metre in length, by 1 metre in width, by 1 metre in height; Normal farm practice, the size shall not exceed 2 metres in length, by 2 metres in width, by 2 metres in height

1. The permit holder shall keep the permit at the site of the burning operation conducted under this permit and shall show the permit upon request to any person in proper authority.
2. The permit holder shall have at the location of the fire sufficient persons and firefighting equipment to control the fires and the permit holder assumes full responsibility for determining the sufficiency of persons and equipment.
3. The permit holder shall keep the fire at least 15 metres from any structure and 5 metres from any combustible material (trees, grass, woodpiles, etc.).
4. The permit holder shall not leave the site of the fire, until the fire has been completely extinguished.
5. The permit holder shall be responsible to determine if restricted fire zone conditions are in effect.
6. The permit holder assumes full responsibility for all damages of every nature and kind which may arise as a result of the fire set by the permit holder and irrevocably agrees to indemnify and save harmless the Township from any claims made against the Township in consequence of damages arising from the fire set by the permit holder.
7. The Township may cancel or suspend the fire permit at any time and immediately upon receiving a notice of such cancellation or suspension the permit holder shall extinguish any fire started under the permit.
8. Any costs and expenses incurred by the Township or any Provincial Authority in controlling or extinguishing the fire set by the permit holder shall be paid by the permit holder.
9. Every person who fails to comply with the terms of this permit is guilty of an offence under the Forest Fire Prevention Act, and/or the Ontario Fire Code and upon conviction is liable to a fine or to imprisonment as provided in the said legislation.
10. NOTE: Prior to the lighting of any fires allowed under this permit, the Community Fire Safety Officer must issue approval. Pre-burn inspections will be performed on site as required.
